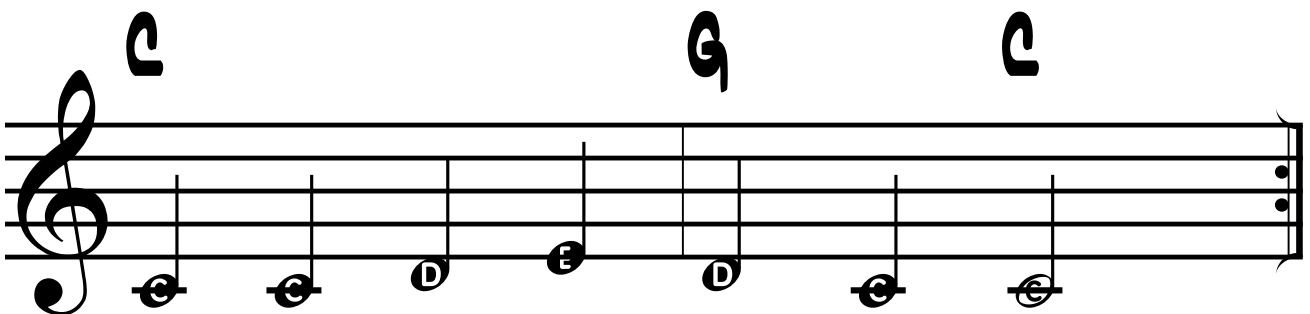
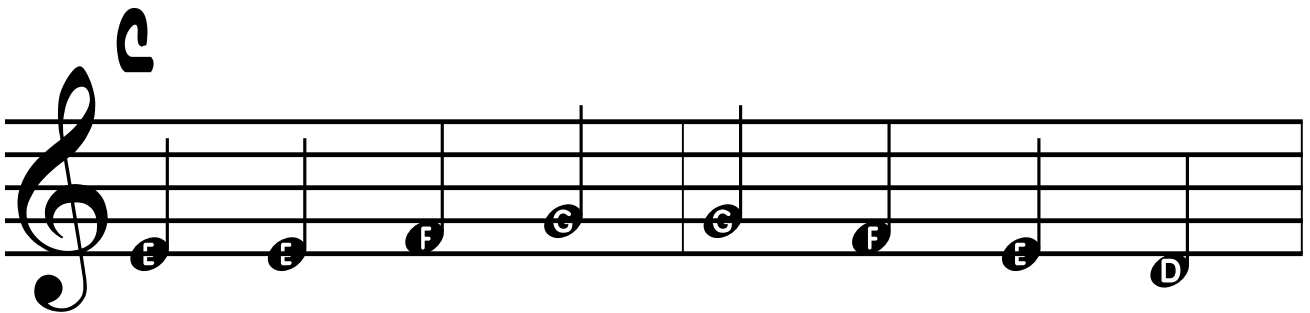
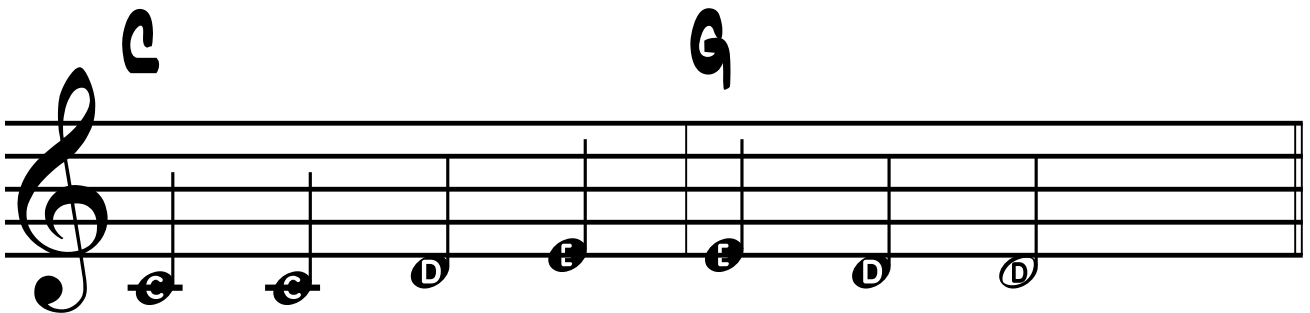
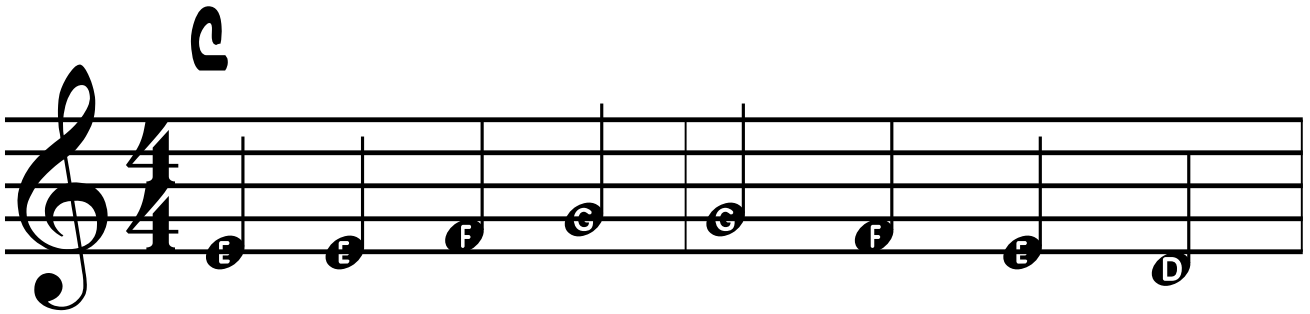


Beethoven's Original Score

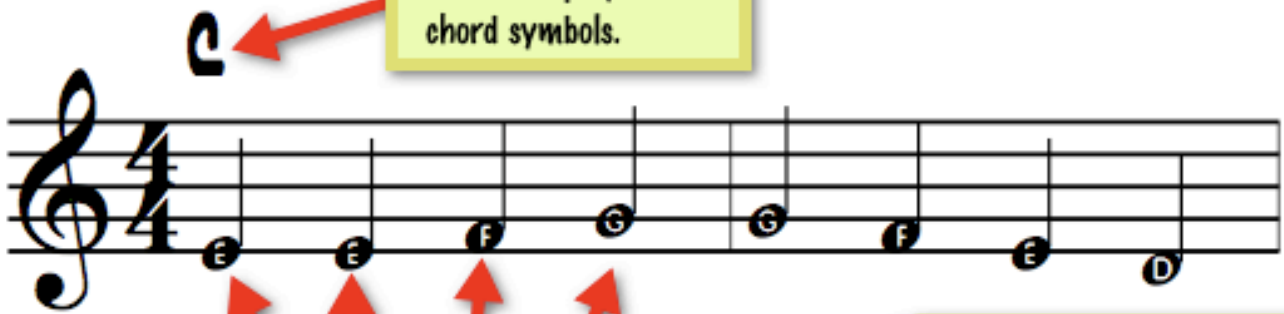

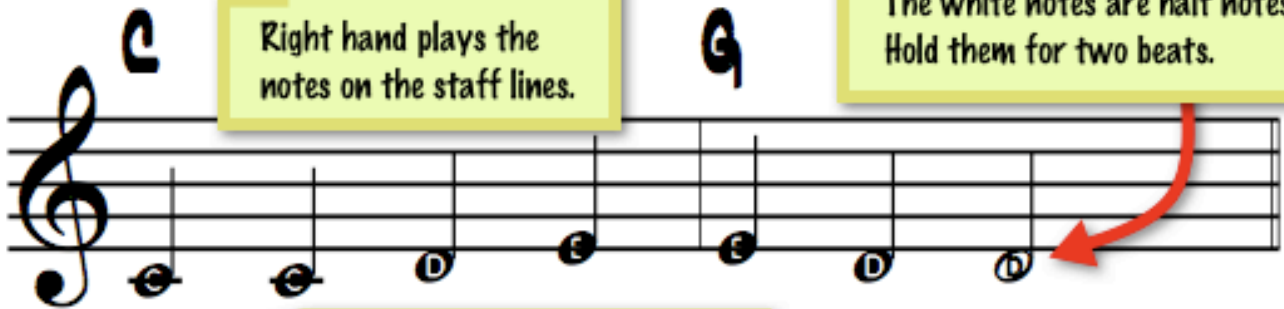
LUDWIG VAN BEETHOVEN

Left hand plays the chord symbols.

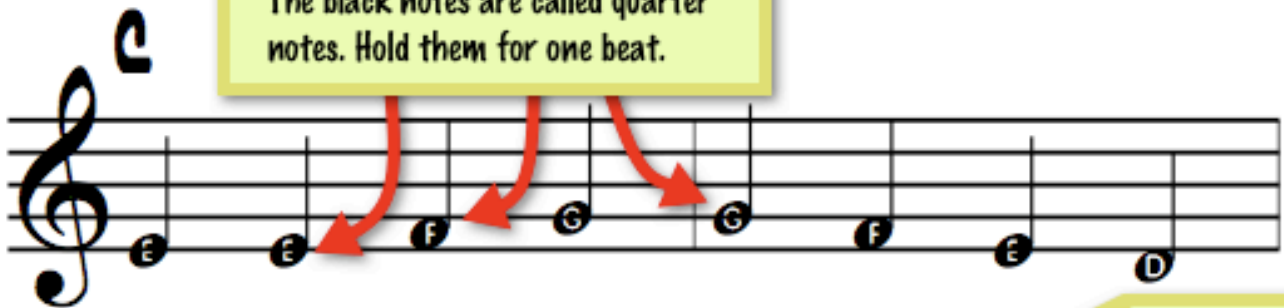


Right hand plays the notes on the staff lines.

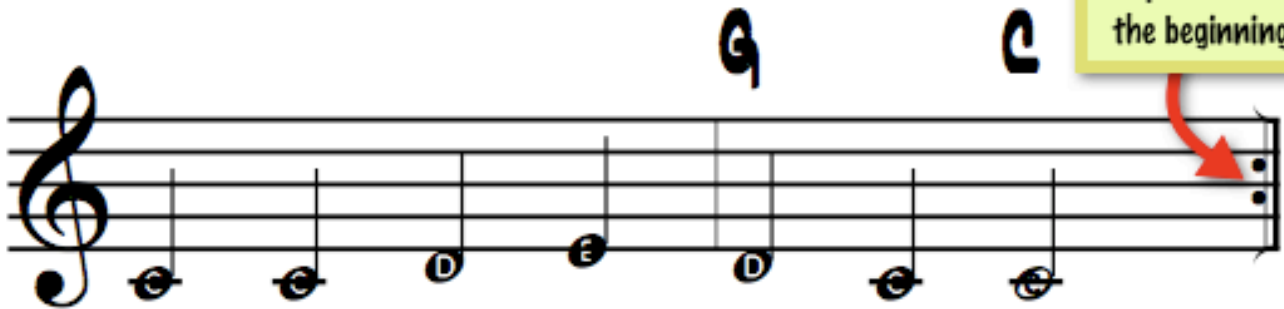
The white notes are half notes. Hold them for two beats.



The black notes are called quarter notes. Hold them for one beat.



Repeat back to the beginning
